When I created WISH Foundation five years ago, my goal was to leverage innovation and technology to improve primary healthcare for the poor and under-served populations around the globe. Almost 6 million children under the age of five die every year, mostly in South Asia and sub-Saharan Africa. That's 15,000 deaths every day! Almost a thousand women die every day in the same regions of causes related to pregnancy and childbirth. India accounts for the largest number of these tragedies, where over 500 million people lack access to good quality primary healthcare. Most of these deaths are preventable - and effective primary healthcare system is the first and most important line of defense to ensure healthy individuals and healthy societies. This led to the genesis of WISH. We are continuing on this journey, enhancing and scaling innovation and technology-enabled primary healthcare models in India. [Learn More](#)

WISH Intervention

WISH firmly believes that in order to reach the underserved populations with quality primary healthcare at such scale in India, we must re-engineer a holistic solution. This must be aligned with the government's vision of universal health coverage. Towards this goal, since 2015, WISH has been successfully piloting and testing diverse programs on the ground in rural, tribal and urban settings; formulating comprehensive primary healthcare service delivery models, that are replicable across the nation. Rajasthan - Technical Support for the expansion of Health & Wellness Centers to the last mile per Govt. of India's National Health Policy 2017 and Scale up tech-enabled HWCs across the state.

Delhi/NCR - Knowledge Management Partner to scale community clinics or 'Mohalla Clinics' from 189 to 1000 and help the government reach its population health goals.

Madhya Pradesh - Technical Support for an optimized urban PHC model; Quality Assurance of Urban PHCs and Performance-Improvement solutions for urban ASHA workers.

Uttar Pradesh - Set up Technology-Enabled HWCs in the priority districts; Design solution for the Prevention and Control of Dengue in support of the National Vector-Borne Disease Control body.
